LETTER FROM OUR PRESIDENT

Much of Heritage Fund's work in 2022 involved looking forward and making the necessary preparations to step up to the next level of serving and improving Bartholomew County. In the foundation world that next level is often measured by assets (we came so close to \$100M), but it also can be measured in positive impacts and the ability to keep alive important but less tangible aspects of the community's legacy.

The Heritage Fund Board worked all year to develop a strategic plan, building from community values and our Diversity, Equity and Inclusion plan, which lays out an exciting new path forward for the community foundation. Some strategic plans make small adjustments; others create significant change. The last big strategic plan for Heritage Fund came about in 1999 and was appropriately titled "Preparing for the New Millennium." Our new strategic plan, as Heritage Fund approaches our 50th anniversary in 2026, could be titled "Stepping Up."

The robust strategic planning process, guided by our consulting team from Johnson, Grossnickle and Associates, included numerous surveys, focus groups and one-on-one interviews with community leaders. The Board understood the challenges it faced as a trusted community institution:

- listen carefully to the community;
- determine where Heritage Fund could focus its resources to make a significant impact;
- model the community values and;
- demonstrate responsible stewardship of donor resources.

The final product is a comprehensive set of tools to guide Heritage Fund work and its allocation of resources. The Vision, Mission, Values and DEI Pledge support each other and the ability of the foundation to make a positive difference in the community.

The Board realized that stepping up to operate in a focused set of impact areas while shouldering the challenge of developing and connecting an emerging group of diverse community leaders would take time and has set aside 2023 as a transition year.

Heritage Fund also will be stepping up with a new look designed around and acknowledging a respected legacy that is open and accepting of new challenges and opportunities. The new logo incorporates the colors of the Bartholomew County Courthouse in a clear and welcoming design.

We look forward to sharing this new path with our donors and community stakeholders over the next several years. Even more, we look forward to the positive changes that can come from working in collaboration with all partners, tapping into the rich diversity that now defines our community and creating new ways for everyone in Bartholomew County to achieve their greatest quality of life.

GRANTS

Heritage Fund's formidable grants program supports the work of local nonprofits with funds to community-wide initiatives, programs and organizational needs that improve the quality of life for the people of Bartholomew County. The majority of grants made each year are directed by our donors to support the organizations and causes they care most about. Additional grants from the Community Fund are made at the discretion of our Board and align with our Areas of Impact.

Early Learning Coordinator

55 percent of young children in Bartholomew County need care because both parents are employed. Of those children, only a little more than half are enrolled in one of the 54 known childcare programs in the county, and only 19 percent attend a high-quality program. In 2022, Heritage Fund partnered with the Community Education Coalition, United Way and Ivy Tech to establish an Early Learning Coordinator position to address the many needs of our local childcare system. The position is supported through the Community Fund at \$50,000 annually through 2024 and will lead community efforts to ensure all families have access to affordable, high-quality childcare, early learning programs and opportunities for children ages birth to 5.



REACH Columbus

REACH Columbus, Inc. provides experiences for adults with developmental or intellectual disabilities to expand opportunities to grow in job knowledge, life skills, healthy lifestyles and social/emotional intelligence. REACH was started by eight parents of adults with special needs. In 2022, Heritage Fund awarded REACH a \$11,500 grant to support the new organization's strategic planning and professional accreditations. Since the grant award, REACH has been able to expand services to more families and individuals in need and recently opened its own facility in Columbus.

Columbus Fellowship Club

Since 1981, the Columbus Fellowship Club has provided a location for individuals seeking recovery from substance abuse through the 12-Step Programs (AA, NA, Alateen, Al-Anon, Nar-Anon and Adult Children of Alcoholics). Currently, the CFC serves as many as 35 different meetings and hundreds of individuals each week. In 2022, Heritage Fund awarded \$50,000 to support necessary building upgrades to the club's location. These upgrades will ensure that the 35-year-old facility is a safe and welcoming space for those seeking treatment for substance abuse and related disorders.



Pigasus Institute

In 2022, Columbus Signature Academy New Tech student Piper Parks won the Project Pigasus statewide screenwriting competition for her original screenplay "Blue." Heritage Fund awarded Pigasus Institute \$7,500 to support the production of Piper's short film, inspired by her struggles with loneliness and depression during the pandemic and finding strength to deal with them through the art and beauty in Columbus. As part of the award, local high school students joined the film's crew to gain professional experience in film and media production. "Blue" will be independently released by Pigasus in 2023.



Students Fund of Hope

Established in 2018, Students Fund of Hope's main goal is to support Flat Rock-Hawcreek School Corporation's students in need. In 2022, Heritage Fund awarded the organization \$5,000 to support programming in the Hope and Hartsville areas. With these funds, Students Fund of Hope was able to open multiple food closets in FRHC schools and support neighborhood programming that provides residents with basic needs of food, clothing and other supplies.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Heritage Fund scholarships enable us to support students as they take the next step in their academic journeys. Close to 100 unique scholarship funds awarded more than \$615,000 in 2022, not only benefiting students but continuing the proud legacies established by our generous donors to whom education is so important.

WOMEN'S GIVING CIRCLE

In 2022, the Women's Giving Circle of Bartholomew County celebrated its 11th year improving lives of women and families in our local community. The program's impact work and grants stayed focused on Early Learning, and in partnership with United Way, Ivy Tech and Community Education Coalition, members were pleased to bring Christine Waters to the community to serve as the first Early Learning Coordinator.

ARCHITECTURE REVOLVING LOAN FUND

Several years ago a small group of people got together to explore the idea of creating a revolving loan fund that would support the significant architecture that has put Columbus, Indiana on the map.

Like many good ideas this one was born of necessity. A substantial number of examples of modern architecture in Columbus are 50 to 60 years old. The "new" Central Middle School is 22 years old! So how does a community help the owners of these significant structures keep the inevitable renovations, repairs and restorations in line with the original design intent?

This community has never sought to mandate design through ordinances or other regulatory means. The thought has been that the value of good design should prevail on its own merits. Given the public nature of many of these structures, budgets also matter, and they don't always allow for consultations with world-class architects, so the idea of a revolving loan available to help buildings owners be able to consult these architects was introduced.

Such a pool of money that could be "loaned" at no interest for a period of time could be an inducement for a group to decide to stick with the original modern design. So Heritage Fund, working closely with the expertise provided by Landmark Columbus Foundation, seemed like a good place to house that pool of money, and \$1 M was raised to establish that fund.

Then came the next challenge — finding the right tax-exempt partner — who stepped forward in 2022 and agreed to accept the five-year, interest-free loan.

First Christian Church already had been working with Heritage Fund and Landmark Columbus on the "Save Our Tower" campaign for restoration of the church's iconic 165-foot freestanding tower designed by architect Eliel Saarinen in 1942. Six hundred thousand dollars was loaned to the Save Our Tower effort, enabling work to get underway as fundraising efforts were finalized.

The community can look forward to a repaired and restored tower on the First Christian Church campus and Library Plaza in 2023 thanks in part to the Architecture Revolving Loan Fund and some very strategic alliances built with partners inside and outside of Bartholomew County.

Saving the architecture that defines this community physically but also at a DNA level is hard work and takes an array of tools, collaborations, trust and support. TRACY SOUZA




COMMUNITY FUND
